\*\*If your child will be ordering from the cafeteria, I will send lunch orders home on Friday's for you to fill out for the next week and send back to me on Monday's. You will need to fill it out for the whole week. If you are going to order on certain days and bring a lunchbox for certain days, just write lunchbox next to the day they will be bringing their lunchbox. (See example at the end of supply lists.) If your child brings a lunchbox, please DO NOT send anything that needs to be microwaved. (More details on all of this will be in the Kindergarten syllabus.)
