1 **SPILL PROOF** water bottle, labeled with child's name. This will need to be sent to school filled up every morning. It will be refilled as needed. (No Dasani, Aquafina, SmartWater, Great Value, etc. water bottles)

1 red and blue plastic 1-inch Kindermat for nap time (No cover. Sorry, no exceptions. This is because of storage!)

1 backpack (NO WHEELS) Please make sure it is big enough to fit a folder, a composition journal, a blanket/jacket, change of clothes, and a lunchbox. I pack everything in backpack at the end of the day to make sure nothing is forgotten!

1 Ziplock bag with extra clothes (with underwear and socks) to be kept in backpack at **ALL TIMES**. (Muddy accidents on playground and water spills happen often!)

### PLEASE PUT ALL THESE ITEMS IN A LARGE BAG WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE BAG AND BRING THE BAG TO ME ON ORIENTATION NIGHT.

\*\*If your child will be ordering from the cafeteria, I will send lunch orders home on Fridays for you to fill out for the next week and send back to me on Monday's. You will need to fill it out for the whole week. If you are going to order on certain days and bring a lunchbox for certain days, just write lunchbox next to the day they will be bringing their lunchbox. (See example at the end of supply lists.) **If your child brings a lunchbox, please DO NOT send anything that needs to be microwaved.** (More details on all of this will be in the kindergarten syllabus.)


- 4 packages sharpened Ticonderoga pencils to turn in to the teacher
